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**Summary:** The City of Rio Dell is seeking bids from responsive and responsible contractors to conduct various asphalt work including grind outs, overlays with geotextile fabric and asphalt patching in various locations in preparation for or coordination with Slurry Sealing. Some work must be completed by June 30, 2019.

### Addendum No. 1:

- 1. Addition of traffic plan: Successful bidder will be required to coordinate all traffic issues with transit services, law enforcement, EMS, Fire and all other users including neighbors. A traffic control plan will need to be provided to the city and approved in advance of any work taking place.**
- 2. Addition of Bid Bond: 10% Required**
- 3. Add: Adjust Utility to Grade (Valve Box) one location on Center and one location on Rigby. Attached is a revised bid schedule Attachment A.**

EXCEPTION TO SPECIFICATION: List all exceptions to specification on a separate piece of paper, attached to the bid.

4. **Clarification: Bid items are unit prices and will be paid based on the field measurements and layout provided by the city. Additional asphalt patch repairs were discussed at the pre-bid field walk; however, for the purposes of the bid, the areas will remain the same. Quantities may be increased depending on bid prices and availability of budget. If so, changes will be made and the awarded contractor will be notified prior to any work taking place.**
5. **Clarification: The city may choose to make minor adjustments to the size and dimensions of the asphalt repair patches shown on the maps and in the field. If so, adjustments will be made prior to any work taking place.**
6. **Clarification: The bid schedule items will be the basis for payment. All other associated items (traffic control, demolition, geotextile pavement fabric, etc.) will be incidental to those items of work and paid for under those items of work.**
7. **The limits of the asphalt repairs are based on the most heavily degraded roadway conditions and the availability of budget. As a result, portions of the road outside the limits identified by the city, may also be cracked and need repair. In these cases, the contractor will be asked to rake some of the asphalt “fines” into the cracks to provide a better transition and surface in preparation for the upcoming slurry seal. This request will be limited to the worst areas and shall not exceed 10’ beyond the asphalt repair areas.**
